Guidelines for judging participants in oratorical competition

Criteria for participants:

- 1. Appropriate business attire
- 2. Authenticity of content (extrapolates some content from Dr. King's speeches)
- 3. Inclusion of theme
- 4. Maintaining eye contact with audience
- 5. Participants can deliver speech using technology, props and other tools. If the speech is not memorized, the use of notes is permissible.
- 6. Email speech to Dean of Students by Saturday, January 11, 2025.

NOTE: Presentations must adhere to time frame and criteria. Contestants are penalized -10 points over or under specified time limit.

Criteria for judging:

- 1. Adherence to dress code
- 2. Articulation of content
- 3. Stage presence (embracing the moment)
- 4. Creativity
- 5. Theme: interwoven into speech (extrapolates some content from Dr. King's speeches)
- 6. Interaction with audience, focus
- 7. Content: research, organization, coherent thoughts
